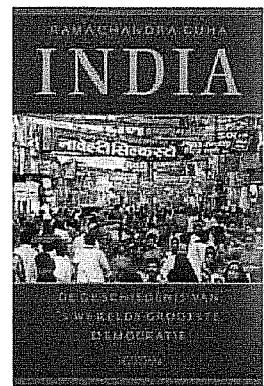
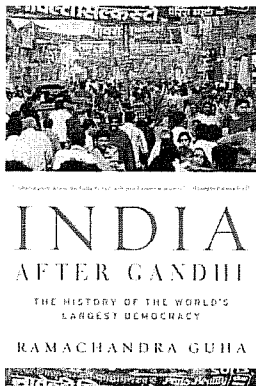

Ramachandra Guha is an Indian historian and columnist. He is the author of the widely acclaimed *India after Gandhi. The history of the world's largest democracy* (2007), which has been translated into many languages, including Dutch. Guha was ranked among the top 50 of India's most powerful people by Bloomberg Businessweek in 2009 and in the top 100 public intellectuals in the world in 2008 by the US magazine Foreign Policy. In 2011-12, he holds the Philippe Roman Chair of International Affairs and History at the London School of Economics.
