This includes:

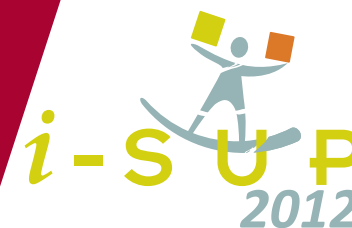
- » Admission to all sections of the conference.

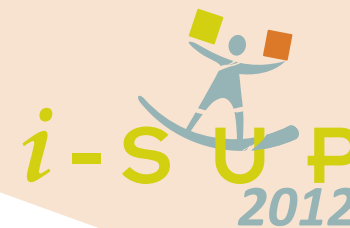

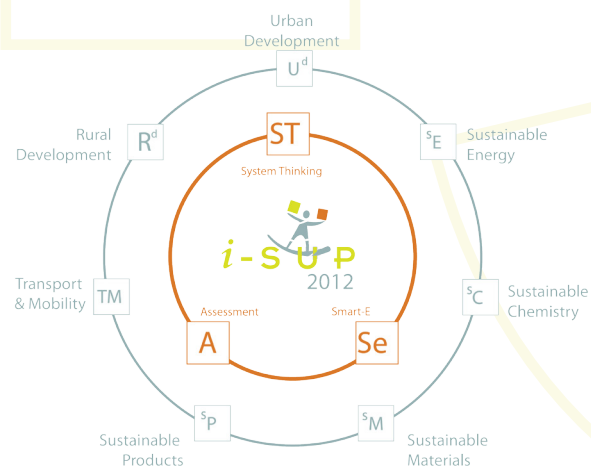
