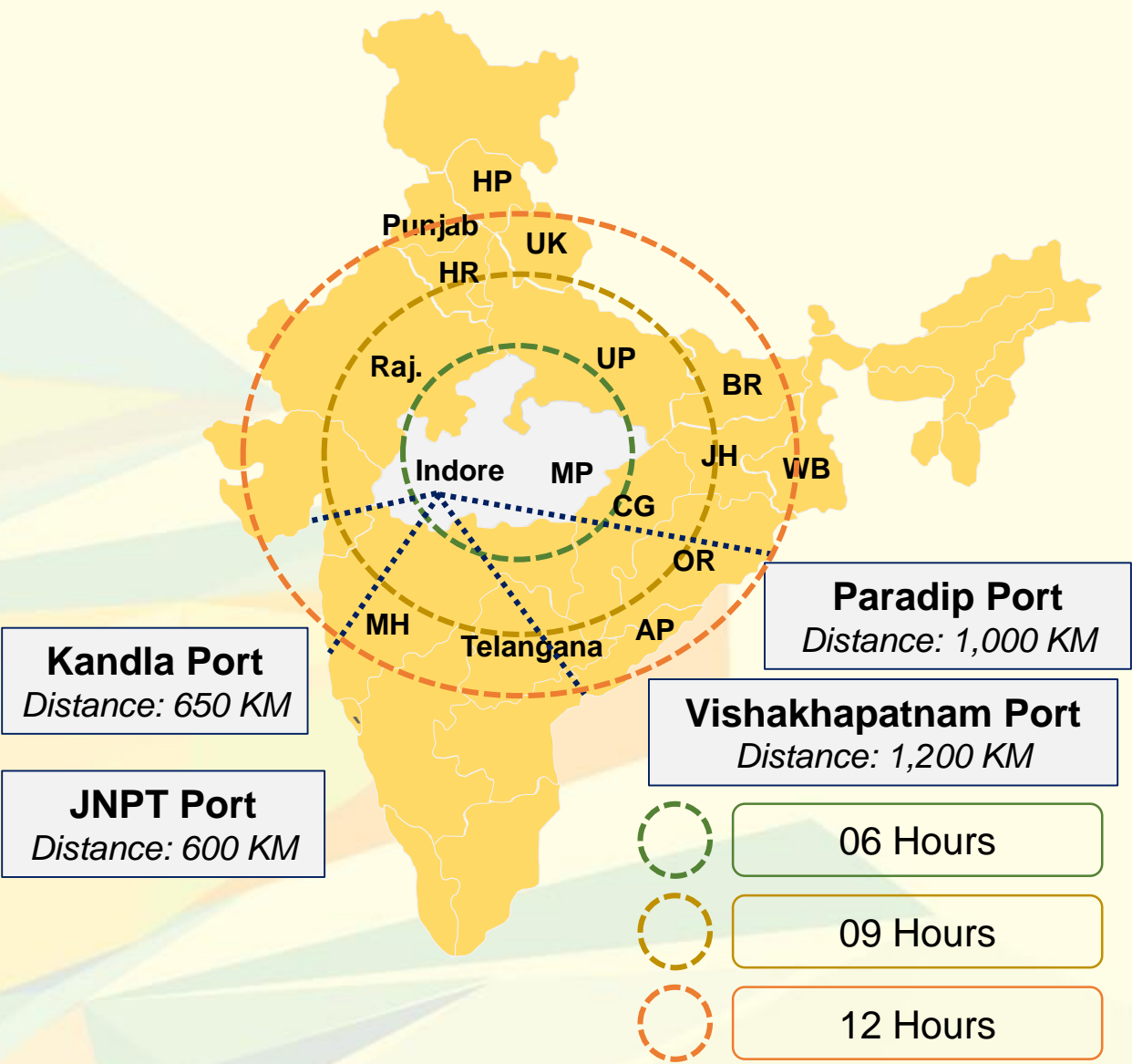

Progressive Policies (1/4)

Only State in the Country with Tax De-Linked investment promotion policy

Investment Promotion Assistance

- **Investment Promotion Assistance:** Tax delinked investment assistance ranging from 40% to 10% of investment in plant and machinery from INR 100 million to INR 15 billion, respectively
 - Incentive on Employment generation: (100-2500 employees): 1 - 1.5 times
 - Benefits to Export oriented units: (25% - 100%): 1 - 1.2 times
- **Power Tariff rebate:** @Rs. 1/- per unit for 5 years (green field projects)
- **Infrastructure Development Assistance:** @50%, limit of INR 30 million (private /undeveloped Govt. Land.)
- **Green Industrialization (Waste Management System):** for establishing ETP/STP @50% with a maximum limit of 10 million

Progressive Policies (2/4)

Only State in the Country with Tax De-Linked investment promotion policy

Textile

- **Interest Subsidy for Textile Industry:** 5% to 7% for 5 years on term loan (TUFS approved Plant & Machinery) for Textile Industry

Pharma

- **Slack period for Gross Supply Value (GSV) Multiple** – 2 year slack period from date of production to comply Gross Supply Value Multiple as stated in IPP 2014 (amendment Dec 2018)
- Facility will continue after 2 years for a period of next 7 years

Food
Processing

- **Investment Promotion Assistance:** 1.5 times additional incentive
- **Mandi Fee reimbursement** for five years is provided for food processing industry

Progressive Policies (3/4)

Special financial assistance for large scale Apparel (garment) units

- **Maximum incentives to the tune of 200%** of investment in plant and machinery
- **Interest subsidy** of 5% for 7 years on term loan for Plant & Machinery (ATUFs approved)
- **Employment Generation Assistance:** INR 5,000/ employee/ month for max. 5 years for new employees for 10 years*
- **Skill development and training expenses:** INR 13,000/ new employee for 5 years for MP domicile employees (reimbursement)
- **50% discount in the development fee** in case of taking lease land in the industrial area
- **Reimbursement of Stamp Duty and Registration Fee** on execution of land lease documents
- **Electricity duty exemption** for a period of 7 years from the date of taking new electricity connection
- **Concession on Power tariff:** Fixed rate of INR 5/ unit on new electrical connection, for 5 years*

* from the date of commercial production

Progressive Policies (4/4)

Incentives Package Logistics & Warehousing Industry

- **Investment assistance** to the tune of 15% (maximum of INR 150 million) on Gross Fixed Capital Investment (except land and residential buildings)
- **Infrastructure development assistance** to the tune of 50% (maximum of INR 10 million) to construct access infrastructure to the site for private/undeveloped government land
- **100% reimbursement of stamp duty and registration fee on Mortgage** executed in obtaining loan logistic & warehousing hub/park and on purchase of land
- **Electricity duty exemption** for 5 to 10 years for new High Tension (HT) connection by a DISCOM
- **Relaxed Floor Area Ratio (FAR)** of 1: 0.60 and maximum ground coverage of 60%

Logistic & Warehousing hub/ parks will be allotted land in developing / developed industrial areas under Department of Industrial Policy and Investment Promotion on 'first come first serve' basis at the prevailing land rate

Public Service Guarantee Act

- GoMP targets to provide required clearances in timebound manner to industries
 - Madhya Pradesh Industrial Development Corporation (MPIDC), the single window secretariat of Industry Department, will act as the nodal agency
- In order to ensure real ease in doing business for industries, 40 services have been identified to be offered in timebound manner
 - **25 Services:** Instant approval
 - **10 Services:** Approval in 7 days
 - **5 Services:** Approval in 15 days
